

A Conversion with Jesus on the Scandals in His Church.

My dear Jesus, what is going on with Your Church? Your shepherds have committed terrible scandals; they lied & deceived us; they covered up horrible things & lived double lives!

My son, be not surprised for did I not forewarn you: "Scandals will come, but woe to he by whom comes the scandal." (Lk 17:1) I prepared you for times like these; be not alarmed. You should rather expect scandals than not too; for, if they did not come, My words would be called into question, and so would I. Believe the Gospel; believe Me. Again, be not surprised that scandals come for I told you they would come.

Yes, but these involve Your apostolic successors, even Cardinals of Your Church!

Indeed, did I not say: "The kingdom of heaven (the Church) is like a net cast into the sea, drawing up good & bad fish." (Mt 13:47) My Bride, the Church, reminded you, in her Catechism of Trent, that "bad fish" include the Church's hierarchy. Again, be not surprised. Believe the Gospel, believe the Church; believe Me. You should rather be surprised if the net held only good fish for than the Gospel would be questioned.

Yes, but, many may leave the Church; and others will not enter her fold!

My son, do not worry about this. Those "who have ears to hear" will still respond to My grace. Those who leave, would have left anyway. These are the seed which sprout, grow &, later, choked by the cares, riches & pleasures of life (Lk 8:14), defect. Again, these are they who want to go their own way and are simply looking for an excuse. Others, who are of My elect, will, amid all the turmoil, hear My voice. Like the crucified One, they will see the Church, bruised & mocked, spat upon & betrayed, and see Me. Amid the scandals, they will see the truth & give God glory. Indeed, scandals in the Church ought to strengthen faith, not weaken it; for, to see the Church corrupted but not destroyed, dying yet not dead (2 Cor. 6:9) is a firm proof of her divine protection. Again, believe the Gospel, believe the Church, heed right reason & believe Me.

Yes, but these are Your shepherds, the hierarchy!

Indeed, they are. In My time on earth, what did I say of the hierarchy, *those who sit upon the chair of Moses*: "Do what they say, but not what they do." (Mt 23:3) This, My proverb, is for all time; it still applies. Believe the Gospel; believe Me, then and now.

Yes, but, much damage has been done; Your Church is sinking!

My son, again, I prepared you for this when I slept in the boat during the terrible storm upon the Sea of Galilee. When the veteran fishermen cried out, "Lord, save us, we are perishing," I rebuked them as I now rebuke you, "Oh, ye of little faith." (Mt 8:26) During this current storm I tell you, "Be still, and know I am God." (Ps 46:10)

Yes, but the *liberal* media...! **Ah My son**, the *liberal* media is My new instrument to correct My Church. In times past, I used evil spirits to free My people from Pharaoh (Ps 77:49) & Muslims to reunite Christendom; now, I use the *liberal* media to heal My Church; they are doing My will without knowing it; for nothing is outside My providence.

To end, my son, for we are running out of space, keep this in mind: "Judgment begins at the house of God" (1 Pt 4:17). Again, as proved through history, if the world is to improve, it must first happen that the Church be cleansed of her rot. (see Collect, 15th Sunday after Pentecost)
