Please place your donation in the envelope along with the deceased person you want remembered.

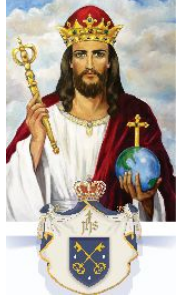
The church will host an evening of fine dining, super entertainment and gracious hostility.
