Thank you for your continued prayers, donations & pledges in support of our building project **Do This in Memory of Me.**

The town hall meeting went well.

Thank you for documenting your pledges through the office or online. These are needed for our future planning & for the accuracy of our thermometer.

The hard numbers for the church & bell tower arrived at \$5.1 million (inclusive of 15% contingency & without the interior artwork.)

By now you have seen the rendering of our proposed Romanesque church. Its façade resembles ancient churches of Rome e.g., the Basilica of St Cecilia Trastevere (3rd century, rebuilt in 822 A.D. & restored in the 18th century), the Basilica of St Clement (a 1st century church, restored in 4th century & again pre-1100 A.D.), and the Church of Gesu has a similar façade, (conceived by St Ignatius of Loyola, construction began June 26, 1568 and, 16 years late, it was finally consecrated, so be patient with our build.) The triangle relief is a symbol of the Triune God we worship; the side buttresses give both strength against hurricanes and a Gothic touch.

It is not a church usual in our day, but neither is the Latin Mass nor Gregorian chant, let alone classic Catholic terms like hypostatic union, transubstantiation, or substance & accident. Catholic restoration is needed on so many fronts!
